



Take Note

1. Please read the Syllabus and all General Rules.
2. To be eligible for a money award, a competitor, in addition to receiving the adjudicator's recommendation, must have performed at least 3 solo classes (excluding Studies); the fourth requirement may be another competitive solo, Studies, Sight Reading, Composition or an ensemble piece.
3. Late deadline is 10pm, January 24, 2025 accompanied by \$25 penalty fee.
4. During the Kiwanis Music Festival Windsor-Essex County, once an entrant is offered a recommendation to Provincial Competition by phone and email, that recommendation becomes null and void if it is not accepted within 24 hours after the offer is made by phone and email.
5. Competitors hoping for recommendation to the Provincial Competition must comply with regulations pertaining to Provincial and Local Festivals. For provincial information and syllabus, visit **www.omfa.ca** or contact Mary Jeanne Peters at kiwanismj@gmail.com at the time of entries or before. In order for a solo performer to earn a provincial recommendation from the Kiwanis Music Festival Windsor-Essex County adjudicator, the registrant must have competed locally in a minimum of three (3) solo classes and achieved a minimum mark of **85 in each** of the three.
6. Open Classes – to be eligible, a competitor must be studying at the ARCT level. Age is not a requirement for these classes but level of study is.

Specific to Woodwinds

- Other than Sonata and Concerto classes competitors are required to perform from memory.
- Competitors must provide their own music stand if they require one.
- The Provincial competition is based on Level/Grades. Those students who wish to progress on to the Provincials are encouraged to enter a "Level" class in this Festival. Please note that this is not required, but advised.
- An original and complete score, including piano part where applicable, must be presented to the adjudicator in every class. Photocopies are not permitted for an adjudicator's copy. Please see the General Rules.
